Heading Back to Frankfort

In 2022, Maryhurst successfully advocated with the Kentucky State Legislature to secure additional critical funding for our unique residential treatment services. We'll now return to

Frankfort to advocate for increased rates for our community-based prevention program, Renewal, which relies on Medicaid reimbursement for the vast majority of its income. Current rates only cover 70% of the cost of providing these critical services.
